I am writing to inform you of the Junior League of Greater New Haven's 2016 High School Voluntarism Scholarship. The award was created to promote voluntarism – our organization's fundamental purpose – and, as such, will recognize up to two female high school seniors in the Greater New Haven area who exemplify a demonstrated commitment to the community and who plan to attend an accredited college, university or vocational school.

Applicants must be nominated by a community organization, school official, or a member of the Junior League. This award is not based on outstanding educational merit or financial need, but on notable, ongoing community volunteer activities that are not part of a required curriculum. In addition to a completed application, applicants must submit a written essay and two letters of recommendation, one from their nominator and one from another adult supervisor. Applications must be received by May 6, 2016, and the chosen recipients will be notified in writing by May 16, 2016.
